Quorum welcomes Balfour Beatty & Ebiquity

Balfour Beatty, the world-class infrastructure services business, and Ebiquity, one of Europe's leading media monitoring companies, have become the latest new arrivals at Quorum.

Balfour Beatty, has opened a new office building at Q14. From this office, Balfour Beatty will provide a centralised financial and procurement service for a number of UK Balfour Beatty companies and other organisations. Recruitment is underway for the initial 100 jobs being created. 60 people are now in post and a further 40 people are in the process of being recruited.

The building is a purpose built office boasting 42,000 square feet of office space. The new state-of-the-art facility has now been fully fitted out which features a number of environmental innovations.


Ian Dawson, CSC Director, said: "We chose the office at Quorum Business Park for its infrastructure. Additionally, the high calibre of individuals that we have recruited demonstrates the vast pool of talent and diverse workforce in the Newcastle area."

"The building design and location expresses our commitment to sustainability. For example, 97.2% of the waste generated in the refurbishment for the building was recycled. In addition, the new Balfour Beatty office is built to a BREEAM Excellent standard – delivering significant savings in CO2 emissions."

Quorum also welcomes Ebiquity, who have invested over £1m in a relocation to the park. Ebiquity have created a brand new, state-of-the-art processing centre in Q5 which will initially employ 210 people in a range of roles from media analysts to team leaders and quality control officers. The AIM listed company's new 18,000 sq ft facility will see its current operational centre in London and an office in Newcastle merged into one single centre creating up to 60 new jobs on-site.

Paul Adams from Ebiquity said: "This is an exciting investment for Ebiquity and we're delighted to be opening a truly world class centre at Quorum. We have a great opportunity to achieve growth around the world and this is a fantastic location from which to do it."

"Quorum has superb facilities, the transport infrastructure is excellent and we have a great skills base here including a vibrant community of international language speakers who are essential to support our worldwide products. The support available in this area is also excellent. We had a choice between Ireland and Tyneside and one of the key reasons we came here was the help we received."
