



Silver Award Level

Sustainable Transport

- Silver Level applicants will be able to demonstrate they promote sustainable transport in the workplace.
- They will be able to demonstrate they have incentivised car sharing, public transport and cycling as a more sustainable option of travel
- Cycling changing facilities are provided onsite and staff are offered a salary sacrifice scheme to assist if they wish to purchase a bike.

Carbon Reduction

- Silver Level Applicants will have explored new innovations beyond energy saving measures installed at build.
- Silver Level Applicants will have a designated Sustainability Representative who attempts to encourage others in the workplace to implement carbon saving behaviours.

Water Saving

- Alongside water saving controls in toilets, Silver Award applicants will have introduced a water saving scheme in kitchens – this could include eco mode dishwashers, installation of a zip tap to reduce water waste or signage to encourage smart water use.

Waste/ Resource Use

- Silver Level Applicants will be able to demonstrate a commitment to reducing waste levels rather than simply relying on recycling as a sustainable solution.
- They will be able to evidence sustainable 'switches' used to reduce waste.

Ecology / Environment

- Silver Level Applicants should be able to demonstrate that they have encouraged staff to consider the environment and ecology in the local area and away from the workplace
- They have advertised the Quorum Wildlife Group and onsite initiatives.
